 The focus of this trip: Tahoe's federal fiscal year appropriations requests consistent with
 authorizations in the Lake Tahoe Restoration Act (LTRA) of 2016, Also, advocacy for
 resumption of the project nomination, approval, and funding process from the Southern
 Nevada Public Lands Management Act (SNPLMA) consistent with the "White Pine"
 amendment.
- Assist Tahoe Fire and Fuels Team (TFFT) Incident Commander (IC) Forest Schafer with final preparations for the virtual MAC meeting on Thursday, April 16.
- Participate in the MAC meeting to provide an overview of the March 9-11, 2020 Lake Tahoe
 Partnership meetings with members of the Tahoe Congressional Delegation and/or their staff.
 These meetings focused on advocating for Tahoe's requests for federal fiscal year
 appropriations consistent with the authorizations in the Lake Tahoe Restoration Act of 2016.

 Notice and Notice of Preparation confirming the Intent of project proponents to begin work on
