Fall was off to a mild start despite the four cold fronts that traveled through the region in October, the hydrology reports from the National Weather Service were unremarkable. Mountain soil moistures as measured by the National Resource Conservation Service (NRCS) SNOpack TELemry (SNOTEL), which is a fancy name for a remote backcountry weather station that measures snow and transmits the data wirelessly, reports down to near average conditions heading into this winter. Currently, the only significant wildland fire potential in the US is in Hawaii and the deep south. Year-to-date acres burned for the United States remains well below the 10-year average at just over 38%, with a near average number of fires as well, about 99% of average. Significant fire activity diminished across northwestern Canada as well, with commitment of United States resources ending in October.

The district continues to prepare with our partners at California Special Districts Association (CSDA), NTPUD and TCPUD to advocate for awareness for all aspects of the financial assistance that our region needs. We participated in the production of a video for promotion to federal and state legislative staff, inviting them to virtual tours and live discussion with special district leadership events in December.

As you know, I am always proud to report on the successes of our fire fighters, who were quick to accept movements to equalize shifts through the holidays, academies, and on boarding of the new staff. Engineer/Paramedic Rhett Stemmler and Firefighter/Paramedic Jeff Rau have each done an outstanding job working in the respective capacity of Captain and Engineer over the last couple of months. They returned to their respective classifications of Engineer/Paramedic and Firefighter/Paramedic on November 27, 2023. Engineer/Paramedic Dustin Hollingsworth has accepted a temporary appointment to fill a current Captain position, where he will serve until February 1, 2024.

I am excited to congratulate the six candidates who successfully completed the promotional examination process for the position of Engineer: Stephanie Lockhart, Brian Hansen, Ted Soloski, Jeff Rau, Will Marshman and Chris Bartow. These successful candidates are now eligible to Work-Out-Of-Class (WOC) and on a promotional list. I'm pleased to announce the first of these promotions to Firefighter/Paramedic Stephanie Lockhart, who has served has a WOC Engineer since the end of October and will take on this new role in early December.

I would like to thank our part-time seasonal Defensible Space Inspector, Manuel Valdez, for his contribution to educate residents and encourage wildfire risk reduction this season.

In closing, I'm proud to be your Fire Chief and serve the citizens and visitors of our district. I want to thank all members of our staff for their hard work and attention to detail in keeping our community safe. And I want to
